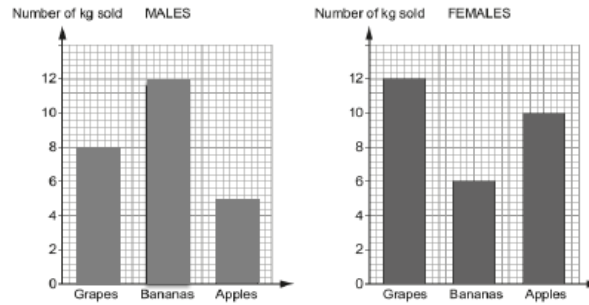


Bryn Solution Seeker
